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In Bible warfare, there are also these kinds of rules so that the discussion can continue in a productive way.

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It keeps the debate in perspective.

## 5. What Makes the Churches of Christ Unique? – Part 1

### A. Theological

New Testament churches are different from others theologically because our approach to the Bible is different in two basic ways:

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Note that the only thing that separates most groups that claim to be Christians is the way they approach and apply the Bible in practical matters.

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The “pattern” theology approach.

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The pattern approach says that the Bible contains “patterns” that guide us in reproducing Christian principles and practices in every age and culture (I Timothy 1:13; Jude 3).

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We are different from other Christian religious groups because we try to follow the principle of “pattern theology” in all we do.

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A good example of this is the area of use of music in worship.

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Every passage that refers to music in the New Testament teaches that we should “sing.”
